

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 768**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XIV OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CENTER, KANSAS, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 14-104 TO PROVIDE DESIGNATED SCHOOL ZONES DURING CERTAIN HOURS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLACEMENT OF SCHOOL ZONE SIGNS ALL FOR THE BENEFIT AND PROTECTION OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CENTER, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CENTER, KANSAS:**

**SECTION ONE.** Section 14-104 is added to the City Code of the City of Lincoln Center, Kansas to read as follows:

**14-104. School Zone.** There is hereby established a school zone on weekdays, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7:30 – 8:15 a.m. and 3:30 – 4:15 p.m. on E. North Street, starting at a point 100 feet west of where N. Industrial Park Drive intersects with E. North Street to a point 100 feet west of where E. North Street intersects with Highway 18. At this location and during this time, there is hereby established a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour and shall be in effect year round.

**SECTION TWO.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper.
